- Place of departure: Register in Refectory 2
- Time of return: 2:50pm

Students will be accompanied by members of staff and will study historical cases.

The cost of this activity is £23 and payments should be made via School Gateway. Alternatively you can pay by cash/cheque (cheques made payable to “Devon County Council”) to the School Accounts Office. Please ensure payments are received by Thursday 16th October 2025.

It is important that the school’s excellent reputation for student behaviour on trips continues and students should wear full school uniform.

We reserve the right not to take any student whose behaviour has given us cause for concern.

Your child may be invited to use a camera on their phone if appropriate for a task on the day, so phones are permitted but taken at owner’s own risk. However, we expect them to be kept in bags at all other times of the day. We expect students to bring basic stationery to complete the work set during the day.

Students will also need to bring a packed lunch. If your child is entitled to Free School Meals they may order one from the refectory the day before the visit. A packed lunch will then be provided free of charge and should be collected from the Refectory on the morning of the visit.
