

Dear families,

Following guidance from Devon County Council and Blackdown Education Partnership (BEP), and in line with our extreme weather risk assessment, we have made some changes to our arrangements for Wednesday and Thursday in order to prioritise the safety and wellbeing of our students and staff.

We are remaining open as normal today (Tuesday 23rd June) although all extra-curricular activities have been cancelled for the remainder of the week. On Wednesday 24th and Thursday 25th June, we have shortened the school day with a finish time of 12:30pm. This will ensure that we balance face-to-face education with reducing exposure to extreme temperatures in the classrooms in the afternoon.

Students can continue to wear their full Tiverton High School PE kit all week, and we ask that all students bring **sun cream, a sun hat, and plenty of water**. All activities will be carefully adapted to minimise exposure to the sun.

Please be aware that if your child travels by bus, we have notified the bus companies of these changes. If your child uses school transport to get home, they will need to report to the assembly hall at 12:30pm where we will supervise them until the busses arrive at 1:15pm.

If your child is going on the Matilda Trip but arrives by school transport in the morning, they must go directly to the assembly hall where they will be supervised until the trip departs.

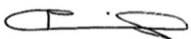
Please email admin@tiverton.devon.sch.uk to let us know if your child will need the school transport provision.
